To Our Students Living in Residence:

St. Clair College is thrilled to be preparing for a return to in-person classes this Fall. The return to face-to-face interaction is the preferred method of delivery and is truly the ideal version of “The St. Clair Experience”. The College will continue to abide by all health and safety regulations and recommendations put forward by federal, provincial and regional health authorities.

In order to stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus, St. Clair College is strongly encouraging all members of the College community to get vaccinated.

For your safety and the safety of other residents, St. Clair College is requiring all students living in residence to have received at least a first dose of a Health Canada or World Health Organization approved COVID-19 vaccine prior to your scheduled move-in date. Proof of vaccination to the College will be required in advance of moving in.

Students will also be required to receive their second dose of the vaccine within the required minimum period and provide proof that they have done so. Students who can receive a second dose of the vaccine prior to arriving on campus are strongly encouraged to do so.

Individuals who cannot get vaccinated for medical reasons or other grounds protected by the Ontario Human Rights Code, can request an accommodation. Specific information on the process to request an accommodation will be provided by e-mail. Accommodation requests should be made as soon as possible and must be made in advance of your move-in date. Please note that if you are requesting an accommodation for medical reasons, you will be asked to submit a form signed by a physician or nurse practitioner confirming you have a medical condition that prevents you from receiving the vaccine.

For your review and information, please find attached an addendum to the 2021-22 Residence Community Living Standards which outlines the College’s COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for students living in residence.

St. Clair College looks forward to welcoming you on campus and we very much look forward to seeing you, in-person, in our residence hallways soon.
